Question:

What is Spiritual Direction? Is it only for priests, deacons, and religious?

Answer:
Not at all! Spiritual direction is for anyone who wants to grow closer to God. Think of it as having a faith companion for the journey. A spiritual director helps you notice where God is at work in your life, whether in prayer, family life, work, joys, struggles, or even those moments when you are sure God must be shaking His head and saying, “What were you thinking?” A spiritual director is not a fortune teller, mind reader, or heavenly GPS. They do not make decisions for you. Instead, they help you listen more carefully to the Holy Spirit and recognize God’s presence in everyday life. Priests, deacons, and religious often seek spiritual direction, but so do teachers, farmers, nurses, parents, students, retirees, and plenty of ordinary people trying to follow Christ one **day at a time**. If you have a soul, spiritual direction is for you! Check with your pastor, for names of spiritual directors.

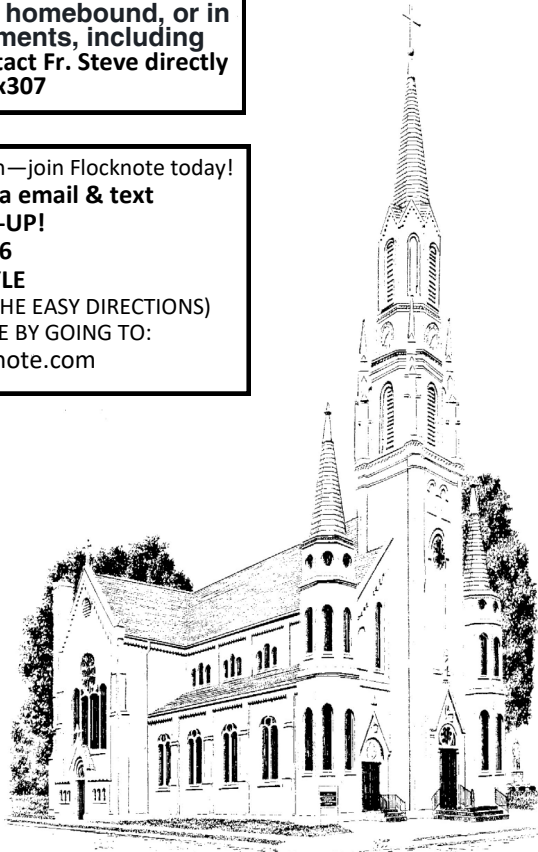

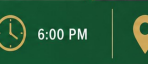

Message from our pastor Father Steve

Sunday, June 14, 2026
11th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Scripture: Exodus 19:2-6a; Romans 5:6-11; Matthew 9:36-10:8

How I Miss Ordinary Time!

I have to admit, after Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, Confirmations, Graduations, First Communions, and enough special events to fill three calendars, there is something refreshing about Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time is when we catch our breath. At least that is the plan. Plans do not always work out. Remember Home Alone 2? Kevin's mother was determined that this year everything would go perfectly. No mistakes. No forgotten children.

The family rushed through the airport. Tickets were handed out. Everybody seemed accounted for. Then she looked down and realized she still had two tickets. One was hers. The other was Kevin's. "Where's Kevin?" As we know, things did not go according to plan. Again. One minute the family is heading for vacation. The next minute Kevin is exploring New York City by himself. Again.

Today's Gospel begins with Jesus looking out at the crowds. He sees people who are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." Then He tells His disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few." In other words, people are getting lost. Not only sheep. People. Parents know this feeling. Teachers know this feeling. Coaches know this feeling. Correctional officers know this feeling. Priests know this feeling.

Every Sunday, I look out at the pews. If I notice a seat that is usually occupied by the same faithful face week after week, I wonder. Are they sick? Traveling? Visiting family? Did something happen? When someone is missing, you notice. Jesus notices too. The difference is that Jesus does not simply notice. He sends laborers. He sends the Twelve into towns and villages to preach, heal, comfort, and bring people back to God. He tells them to get moving because there is work to do.

The same mission belongs to us. Most of us will never wander through New York City like Kevin McCallister. But plenty of people get lost in other ways. They drift from prayer. They drift from Mass. They drift from hope. Sometimes they simply need someone to notice they are missing. A phone call. A visit. A conversation. An invitation. A prayer. The harvest is still abundant. The laborers are still needed. While Kevin's family managed to lose him twice, Jesus never loses track of a single one of His children. That is good news for us. Because sometimes we are the laborers. And sometimes we're Kevin.
