Question: My son came home the other day and said he thinks he would make a good priest. I have never pushed the idea or even talked much about it. Part of me smiles. Part of me immediately thinks, "There go the grandkids." What should I say?

Answer:

First, do not panic and do not start measuring him for Roman collars by supper time. A vocation usually begins quietly. The best response is simple. "That is wonderful. Let's pray about it together." Pray for him. Support him. Encourage him to talk with your pastor or a vocation director. If God is calling him, He will make that clear in His way and in His time. If not, you still get a son, which is a very good vocation too!

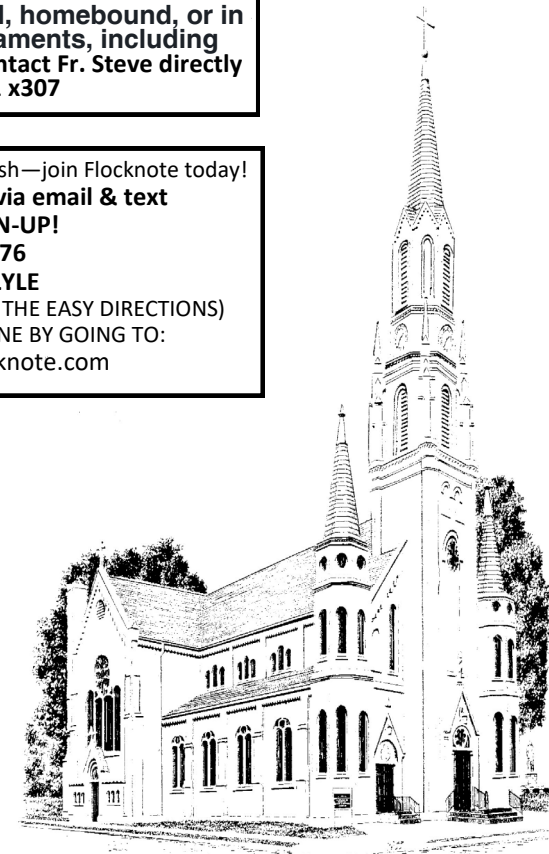

Message from our pastor Father Steve

Sunday, June 7, 2026

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)
Scripture: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a, 1 Corinthians 10:16-17, John 6:51

All right, here goes my confession. This past Friday, I found myself traveling through the Belleville area. As I headed north on Illinois 159 into Fairview Heights, there it was! Bright yellow letters. A glowing orange sign. A beacon of temptation calling my name. "Krispy Kreme Donuts. HOT NOW!" Let's be honest. How many people can resist those two words? HOT NOW! This Padre has very low resistance when it comes to warm donuts. Before I knew it, I had pulled into the parking lot and purchased a six-pack of sugary delight and fluffy goodness. And yes, for those keeping score at home, half of them were gone before I reached the O'Fallon exit.

What can I say? The spirit was willing, but the willpower was weak. There is something about fresh donuts. They are warm, satisfying, sweet, and for a brief moment all seems right with the world.

This weekend, the Church places another invitation before us. Not "HOT NOW." Not glazed. Not sprinkled. Not filled with cream. Yet far more satisfying. Far more nourishing. Far more important. Jesus says in today's Gospel, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever." Think about that for a moment. Every day people line up for things that promise happiness. New gadgets. New cars. Bigger houses. Better jobs. Donuts fresh off the conveyor belt. Yet every one of those things eventually leaves us wanting more.

The Eucharist is different. The Eucharist is not simply a reminder of Jesus. It is Jesus. Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The same Christ who walked the shores of Galilee. The same Christ who healed the sick, forgave sinners, carried the cross, and rose from the dead. He comes to us under the humble appearance of bread and wine. What amazes me is that God did not choose to remain distant. He chose to remain close. So close that we receive Him into our very bodies.

Every Mass is God's "HOT NOW" sign flashing before the world. Come and receive. Come and be nourished. Come and find strength. Come and receive eternal life. Unlike those donuts, which disappeared somewhere around O'Fallon, the gift of Christ never runs out. His grace never grows stale. His love never expires. Week after week, year after year, He waits for us at this altar with the same generosity, the same mercy, and the same promise of eternal life. And that is truly sweet.
